For the reasons explained herein, the order was based on false representations by Respondent in his own DV filing and I am seeking to modify or extinguish it.

6 I, BRITTINY LITTLE, declare as follows:

- 7 1. I am the Petitioner in the above-referenced action and have personal knowledge of the facts  
8 contained herein except whereas stated as based on information and belief. I declare under the  
9 penalty of perjury that if called to testify I could competently do so under the laws of the state  
10 of California that the following is true and correct.
- 11 2. I need this Court’s protection, as JAMES COLE, hereinafter “Respondent” or “James”, is my  
12 ex and the father of my child, and he has a history of physically abusing me, emotionally  
13 abusing me, hiding our son from me, and putting our son in danger.
- 14 3. Our child is G.P.J.C., born May 5, 2023, age three (3) months (hereinafter “our son” or  
15 “G.C.”).
- 16 4. Respondent’s abusive conduct has escalated in recent weeks. On August 6, 2023, I broke up  
17 with Respondent, which has caused his conduct to escalate. I am afraid of what Respondent  
18 might do next to harm our son or me.
- 19 5. Almost all of the recent abuse has taken place in San Mateo County.
- 20 6. **I respectfully ask that this Court grant the following requests:**
- 21 **a. Issue a *Domestic Violence Restraining Order*, protecting G.C. and me from**  
22 **Respondent;**
- 23 **b. That I may have sole legal and physical custody of G.C.**
- 24 7. Procedural and Background Information: Respondent and I are parties to another case: San  
25 Mateo County case number 23FAM01674. Respondent initiated a frivolous, fabricated  
26 domestic violence proceeding in order to gain temporary sole custody of our son. His request  
27 for custody was outrageous for many reasons, namely that I had been our son’s primary  
28 caregiver. I will answer Respondent’s allegations in that case in a separate formal response.

- 1 8. I did obtain an *Emergency Protective Order* against Respondent. See Exhibit 1.
- 2 9. Respondent has also obtained an *Emergency Protective Order* against me.
- 3 10. This is the first time I have sought a *Domestic Violence Restraining Order* against
- 4 Respondent.
- 5 11. I am a travel nurse, and I used to live in Washington State. I met Respondent online in June
- 6 2022. At the time, I was working in Fresno. About a month later, Respondent invited me to
- 7 live with his family in Milpitas; he said he did not want to be in a long-distance relationship. I
- 8 decided to take a chance on a relationship with Respondent. I turned down an excellent job
- 9 opportunity in Southern California and accepted Respondent's invitation to live with him and
- 10 his family in Milpitas. His family was shocked by my arrival and asked why I was in their
- 11 home. They were not expecting anyone to move in with them. Accordingly, I left, scrambled
- 12 to find a place to live, and looked for a job. For a few months, I jumped from one temporary
- 13 solution to another.
- 14 12. Respondent broke up with me in the fall of 2022. I found out I was pregnant with our son in
- 15 November 2022 and informed Respondent right away. We started living together at my
- 16 apartment in Redwood City in approximately December 2022. Respondent refused to pay
- 17 rent.
- 18 13. Our son G.C. was born on May 5, 2023.
- 19 14. Outside of G.C. and Respondent, I have no friends or family in California.
- 20 15. **Respondent has a history of emotionally and physically abusing me. He shows a pattern**
- 21 **of controlling me, getting angry at me, hurting me, taking our son from me, and hiding**
- 22 **him at locations where I cannot find him.**
- 23 16. Moreover, Respondent smokes marijuana every day and lives in his family's garage. He has
- 24 never financially supported our son or me. He does not have the means or ability to properly
- 25 care for our son.
- 26 17. I need this Court's help to ensure that Respondent cannot abuse G.C. or me, and that G.C. is
- 27 safe in my sole custody and care.
- 28

1 18. History of Abuse:

2 19. On or about August 6, 2023, I broke up with Respondent while we were in my apartment. I  
3 also told Respondent that he would not be able to stay in my apartment anymore. Respondent  
4 instantly became angry with me. He grabbed his keys and our son and took him toward the  
5 front door. **This made me nervous, because Respondent had taken our son away from me  
6 to an undisclosed location on two prior occasions, both when he had been angry at me. I  
7 was scared Respondent would take our son and hide him from me again.**

8 20. I asked Respondent to stop and to think rationally before he moved around so fast with our  
9 son in his arms. G.C. was drinking from a bottle, and I was worried that all of Respondent’s  
10 quick movements would cause him to choke. I asked Respondent to slow down, stop, or hand  
11 our son to me. He refused. I got close enough to retrieve the bottle from G.C.’s mouth to  
12 prevent aspiration. **Respondent began screaming, “She’s pushing me!” Respondent  
13 pushed me away from him using his right arm.**

14 21. I called 911 immediately, notifying them that Respondent was trying to take our son from me.  
15 Next, I went to my neighbor’s door and asked him to stay with me in the hallway, and he  
16 agreed. Respondent stood in the hallway with us, yelling at us.

17 22. The police arrived and determined I was not a threat. The police and I tried to work together  
18 with Respondent to write out a parenting plan, but **Respondent refused.** Respondent  
19 requested a CPS assessment, so police waited about three (3) hours with us until CPS arrived.

20 23. The CPS social worker spoke with both of us individually and asked me why the people in the  
21 hallway were saying I was not a good mother. I was so confused—I have no family or friends  
22 here and had no idea 1) why there were people in my hallway or 2) why anyone would say I  
23 am not a good mother. I looked in the hallway and saw a group of Respondent’s friends and  
24 family (some I had met, and some I had never met) congregating there. **Apparently, they had  
25 tried to make accusations against me as the CPS social worker walked into my home.**  
26 These people had never even been to my home before. What’s more, when they saw me  
27 looking out at them in the hallway, **some of Respondent’s family and friends yelled at me  
28 and threatened me. I felt incredibly threatened and intimidated by their presence and**

1           **their attempts to slander me in such a potentially life-altering way. The CPS social**  
2           **worker determined I was not a threat; there was no need to take G.C. away from me.**

3           24. The police had to escort Respondent's friends and family members out of my hallway and out  
4           of my building. Around midnight that night, I went to the parking garage so I could make  
5           room for Respondent to leave. I noticed Respondent's friends and family were congregating  
6           there, intimidating me again. **Again, police had to ask Respondent's friends and family to**  
7           **leave.**

8           25. Accordingly, I sought an *Emergency Protective Order*, which was granted. See Exhibit 1.

9           26. **However, I am still terrified that Respondent, his friends, and his family will return to**  
10           **my apartment to intimidate me. Now they know my gate codes and exactly where I live.**  
11           **Moreover, his friends and family have shown that they are not afraid to ignore police**  
12           **directives. I am scared that they will all come back to find me.**

13           27. **Respondent has also subjected me to ongoing emotional abuse.** Our son was born on May  
14           5, 2023, and since his birth, I have suffered from physical and emotional ailments, notably  
15           including postpartum depression. Respondent has tried to manipulate me and use my  
16           postpartum conditions to his advantage.

17           28. Moreover, I have a history of growing up in foster care. I do not have strong family or  
18           emotional ties to anyone. Respondent, on the other hand, has a strong, unified family, and **he**  
19           **repeatedly uses his family ties to control me and keep me under his thumb.**

20           29. First, after I was discharged from the hospital following G.C.'s birth (on or about May 7,  
21           2023), I felt immense physical pain. I told Respondent and his mom, who is an  
22           obstetric/gynecologic Nurse Practitioner, about my pain, and they ignored me. I told them I  
23           wanted to go to the hospital. **Respondent took our son from me, called CPS, and left me by**  
24           **myself.**

25           30. I went to the hospital, still in immense pain. My blood pressure was skyrocketing, I had blood  
26           clots, and I was near a state of seizure, so I had to stay in the hospital for a week. For the  
27           entire week, I missed my newborn baby, but Respondent would not bring him for me to see  
28           him.



- 1 31. When I was discharged from the hospital, G.C. returned to my care.
- 2 32. In the period after G.C.'s birth, I was diagnosed with postpartum depression and started taking  
3 Zoloft.
- 4 33. In the following months, I started working at Kaiser and could not transfer any of my prior  
5 healthcare providers or medications, because Kaiser is not compatible with most outside  
6 medical service providers. Accordingly, I lost psychiatric care and started to feel unlike  
7 myself; it felt like my postpartum depression symptoms were returning.
- 8 34. Later, on or about July 4, 2023, Respondent and I went to visit his family in Moreno Valley.  
9 While we were there, Respondent's family isolated me and made me feel excluded, rejected,  
10 and humiliated. I noticed everyone was whispering and appeared to have a secret from me. I  
11 found out that Respondent's brother had invited everyone to his son's first birthday party but  
12 specifically excluded me. The next day, I still felt embarrassed and wanted some space. I was  
13 napping in a bed, when the cops suddenly came into the room where I was sleeping and  
14 started asking me questions. I was later informed that Respondent and his family called the  
15 cops on me, while I was sleeping, telling them I was suicidal and depressed. I was indeed  
16 dealing with postpartum depression, but I was not suicidal. I was napping.
- 17 35. I voluntarily went to the hospital, where I was asked to stay for forty-eight (48) hours to  
18 confirm my safety. After I was cleared to leave, nobody came to get me. **Despite ostensibly**  
19 **caring for me so much that they called police to check on me while I was *sleeping*,**  
20 **Respondent and his family could not care enough to come pick me up from the hospital.**  
21 I took an Uber to get back to G.C., Respondent, and Respondent's family.
- 22 36. Between the dates of July 19, 2023 and July 22, 2023, **Respondent took our son and hid**  
23 **him from me.** On or about July 19, 2023, I returned from a walk to find police looking for me  
24 outside of my apartment. I was so confused. The police asked me to stay with them. They  
25 informed me Respondent was inside packing and going to take G.C.. Worried, I tried to go  
26 inside, but the police officer threatened to detain me. Once the officers understood that the  
27 apartment was mine, not Respondent's, and that G.C. was my baby, they allowed me to go up  
28 to my apartment.

1           **37. However, at that time, Respondent was leaving, taking G.C. with him, and he refused to**  
 2           **talk to me. I had no idea why Respondent was taking G.C. or where they were going.**  
 3           **This terrified me.** I repeatedly called Respondent and asked him to bring G.C. back. He  
 4           refused to communicate with me. I was distraught not knowing where G.C. was or if  
 5           Respondent would ever bring him back. Finally, on or around July 22, 2023, Respondent  
 6           brought G.C. back to me. He had taken him to his brother’s son’s first birthday party (to  
 7           which I was not invited) but refused to communicate that to me ahead of time. **Respondent**  
 8           **kidnapped G.C. from me for days and has left me in a state of fear that he will take our**  
 9           **son and not tell me where they are again.**

10          38. Respondent also has a history of taking financial advantage of me. **He has never financially**  
 11          **supported our son or me.** In fact, since I met Respondent, I have sent him over \$10,000  
 12          using cash apps when he has said he needed help. Based on Respondent’s statements to me, I  
 13          believe that Respondent committed Pandemic fraud by taking out loans for two nonexistent  
 14          cars for a total of approximately \$75,000, and he has not recovered from the substantial debt  
 15          he incurred.

16          39. Because of his financial situation, Respondent lives in the uninsulated garage of his family’s  
 17          home. **If G.C. were to be in his care, he would have to live and sleep in unsafe conditions.**

18          40. **Moreover, because of Respondent’s daily marijuana use, I fear for G.C.’s safety if he is**  
 19          **left alone with Respondent.**

20          41. Finally, because Respondent has a history of physically abusing me—mostly when he is  
 21          angry—I fear for what he may do to our son if he is left alone in his care.

22          42. Relief Requested: **It is vital that this Court issue a *Domestic Violence Restraining Order,***  
 23          **protecting G.C. and me from Respondent’s abuse.**

24          43. **I also request sole legal and physical custody of G.C.**

1 44. **I am terrified of what Respondent might do when he is made aware of the instant**  
2 **request**, but I cannot let that fear stop me from protecting my family from further emotional  
3 harm. It is important that both G.C. and I are protected by a court order, so that Respondent  
4 cannot abuse or harm him or me again.


